Heather's Health Corner...

Research proves that 1 in 3 cancers are related to what people eat. The Brassica Vegetable Family are powerful in preventing cancer so make sure you eat your vegetables each day!

Try to include cauliflower, brussel sprouts, broccoli, cabbage, horseradish, arugula, watercress and wasabi in your diet. These are all members of the cruciferous family and are a huge benefit to maintaining a healthy body.

Enjoy your potatoes also! Potatoes are loaded with potassium. In a recent study people who ate large amounts of potassium had a 20% lower risk of suffering a stroke. Potassium also helps lower blood pressure. It is much safer to get potassium from food as opposed to supplements so think about how you can include it in your meals this week.

It is now only a few weeks before our annual Missions Trip to Kenya, which will take place in March. Mal May from Frankston, VIC will be travelling with me on his first visit to Africa.
