There are many ways we are reaching out to Kenya.
As well as our specific mission projects, we are involved with the following:

Taxi bikes to raise incomes.

Cost: AU \$100. per bike

Purchasing Dairy Cows - to help feed families and milk sold to raise income.

Cost: AU \$700. per cow

Purchasing Goat Herds (8 goats)-

Which help feed families and milk sold to raise income.

Cost: AU \$300. for herd

Purchasing seeds and fertilizers for farming -

which feeds families and provides a source of income when crops are sold.

Cost: AU \$150. per acre

Purchasing Bibles. **Cost: AU \$10. per bible**

CHILDREN'S HOME

Siritanyi Children's Home in *Bungoma, Kenya* is home to many orphaned, abandoned and severely disadvantaged children.

Bungoma has countless numbers of orphaned children due to HIV aids, many other diseases and extreme poverty.

The Home is run by the End Time Harvest Church. This church, along with nearly 70 others, is led by Bishop Fredrick Ogara who is closely linked with John Cairns Ministries Inc. and Alliance International Ministries.

Over the years they have cared for a number of abandoned orphans and children but they have also had to turn away so many more, due to the major financial challenges in feeding, clothing and educating the children, as well as paying salaries to the staff.

There are presently 20 children in the orphanage with more expected in the next few months. The Home works closely with the ministry of Social Services in Kenya.

They employ a nurse, a social worker, one teacher, a babysitter and cook, one couple who act as home parents and two watch men.

As a Ministry we are supporting the orphanage and children but they need so much more.

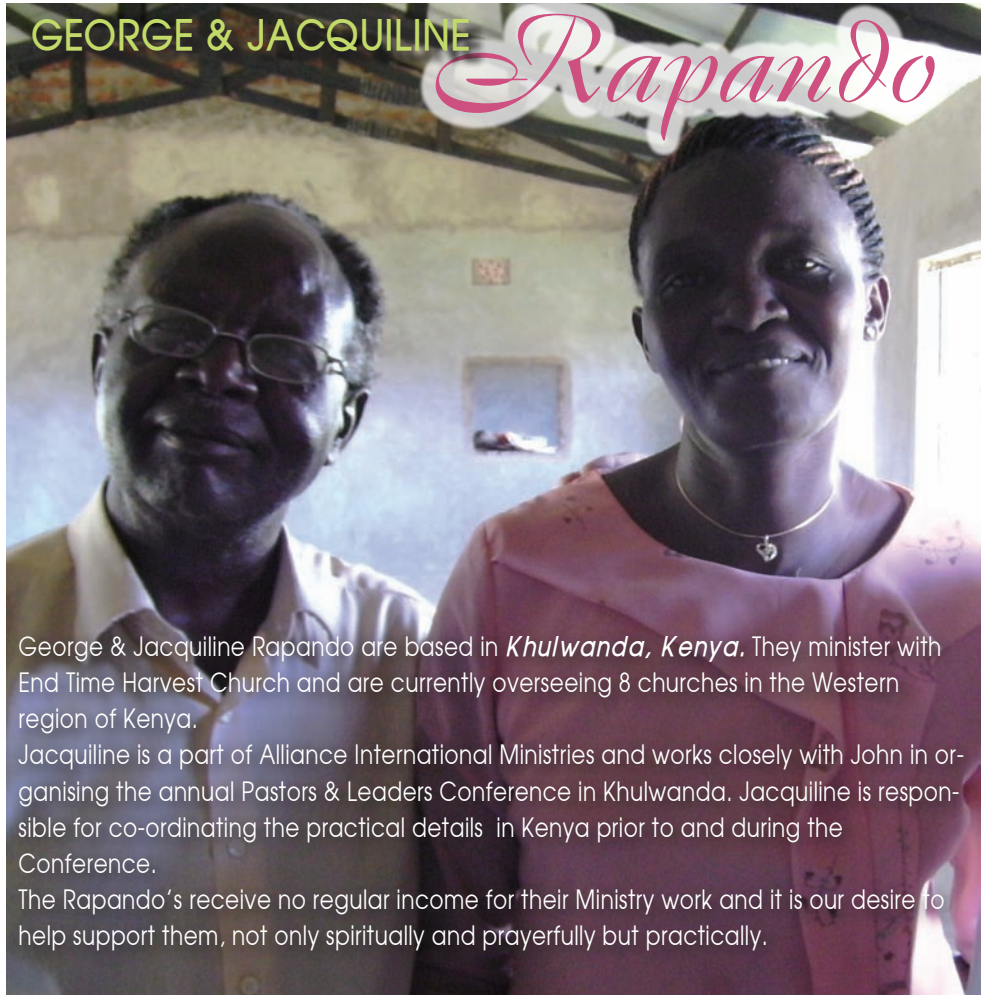

Jacquiline is a part of Alliance International Ministries and works closely with John in organising the annual Pastors & Leaders Conference in Khulwanda. Jacquiline is responsible for co-ordinating the practical details in Kenya prior to and during the Conference.

The Rapando's receive no regular income for their Ministry work and it is our desire to help support them, not only spiritually and prayerfully but practically.



The following are just some of the ways in which you can help:
